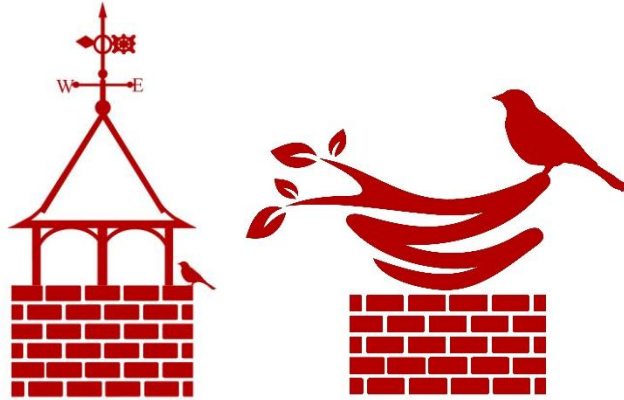




Juniper Hill School Oracy Statement
