We try our best every day.

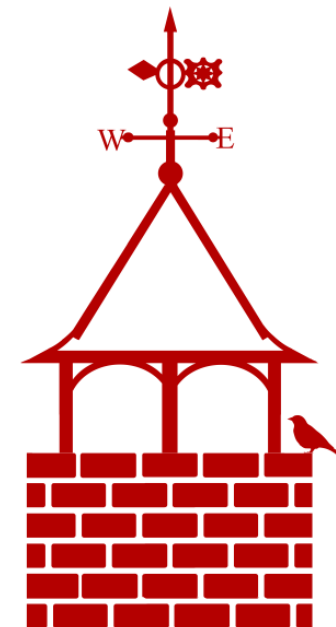

## The school will
